The secret to success in taking photographs with a mobile phone is a God-given zoom, says Adam Howard.

Get up close to the subject you are photographing, he said. Fill the viewfinder. Otherwise, the people and other objects in the photograph will look small and distant.

“Getting close is the most important thing to remember,” Howard said.

Howard shared a few photography tips on the Valentine’s program for the Florence Rotary Club on Monday, March 12. A former president of the club, he said his objective was to teach his Rotary colleagues “how to take better photographs for your sweetheart.”

In addition to getting close to the subject, Howard offered the following tips:

- ⇒ **Get to know your camera** - Learn as much as you can about your camera’s resolution, brightness and shooting mode. Experiment with angles so not every picture has the main image in the center of the shot like a portrait.
- ⇒ **Observe the rule of thirds** - The “rule of thirds” is a principle designed to give balance to a photographic composition. Divide the frame into three parts horizontally and vertically by drawing imaginary lines. Position the most important element in the picture - the focal point - at one of the four intersections of lines.

“Put the focal point on one of those spots and you will have a more dynamic image,” Howard said. “It will draw your eye in a little bit deeper.”

- ⇒ **Get the right light** - Howard recommended not using the flash on a mobile phone, because the digital technology “will try to squish the light and colors into one,” he said. “Natural light produces a more realistic color.”

If you need more light, use a shade or screen or some type that will reflect light on the subject of the photograph.

- ⇒ **Take photographs with people in them** - people give life to a photograph.
- ⇒ **Keep the lens clean** - wipe the lens clean before taking a photograph.

Howard put the Rotarians to the test with a picture taking contest after the presentation. Gary Wilmhoff shot the best still life; Greg Palmer, the best selfie; and Dennis McEvoy, the best portrait.
