Volunteer Life Coach Offers Recipe for Fulfillment

The primary ingredients in Tony Aloise's recipe for a fulfilling life are passion and purpose.

Aloise worked 35 years in supply chain management, 21 as a global material supply manager for Procter & Gamble. He looked forward to going to work every day most of those years. Then he retired.

"I was fearful I would not find that passion in retirement," he said. "I am happy to tell you I not only found a passion, I also found a focus."

He found a passion and a focus by creating Life Solutions Network, a group of volunteers who help people struggling with financial distress, unemployment, illness and other life challenges. His network of volunteers provide mentoring, financial and job coaching, life skills instruction and problem-solving to needy people and organizations.

Aloise explained his recipe for fulfillment in life to the Rotary Club of Florence at a recent luncheon. He said he found a formula for defining one's purpose and discovered a passion for volunteer work through a deep self-examination of his skills, values, strengths and needs.

"I came to see it more as a recipe" than a formula, he said. "It's a set of ingredients.

"It's about knowing yourself deeply.

That's the prelude to purpose. Purpose is a result of discovering and knowing who you are."

Aloise said he never worked as a volunteer prior to retirement. But he developed a passion for volunteering by mixing the ingredients in his recipe - passion, personality, potential and desires - with significant experiences in his life.

First, he became a more caring mentor for one of his sons, who moved closed to him. Then he began to envision playing in the floor with grandchildren. That vision grew into a passion and purpose for mentoring.

"Visions come alive when you can see them, smell them, hear them, touch them and they touch you emotionally," Aloise said.

He encourages people seeking to find purpose to determine what they value in life - what makes a great day in their life and how they know it. He also urges them to identify their skills and to assess their emotional needs, physical needs and intellectual needs.

"Values cause us to take action," he noted.

Aloise said people often spend more time planning a vacation than planning life. What they ultimately achieve, however, is a result of significant life experiences.

"It's not about thinking," he said. "It requires some action."

If you do one important and purposeful task a day, "you can transform yourself and change the world."
