Florence Rotary Recognizes Paul Harris Fellows

The Rotary Club of Florence has recognized more than a dozen members and supporters for "making smiles happen" around the world.

The club honored six members as Paul Harris Fellows at a recent luncheon at the Cincinnati Airport Hilton for their contributions of \$1,000 this year and/or in multiple years to The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International.

The club also recognized two Major Donors, members whose cumulative donations have totaled more than \$10,000. And, the Florence Rotary Foundation provided funding to name five other members or supporters Paul Harris Fellows.

The Rotary Foundation is the engine that drives club service projects around the globe, according to Greg Palmer, chairman of the Florence foundation.
