

Next we toured the Senate, House of Representatives, and Judicial chambers, where we were joined by State Senator and Majority Floor Leader Damon Thayer. Leader Thayer shared his thoughts on the super majority in both houses, <u>our new governor</u>, the approved hemp bill and the possibility of passing a bill allowing sports wagering.

lext, we enjoyed a lunch in the Capitol Annex with Senator Schickel and Representatives Kim Banta, Adam Koenig and Ed Massey. A lively discussion followed on topics including sports wagering, education, health coverage, medical marijuana, taxing districts and more. The day concluded with our group attending the Senate opening session where we were recognized from the floor by Senator Schickel, along with receiving a Senate Citation honoring the Rotary Club of Florence.
