NTI Model Options for 2020-21 Schedules

- <u>Schedule Rotation:</u> Under this model the school would assign students to groups that would attend school on alternating patterns, such as A-B days, AM/PM patterns or alternating weeks.
- Synchronous Opt-in: Parents may choose whether their children attend school in person or virtually. Instruction would be delivered synchronously to students who are at school and at home through virtual live streaming
- <u>Hybrid:</u> Students would be sorted into two groups and would alternate periods of time in the school building and periods of time receiving synchronous instruction at home.
- <u>Fully Online:</u> students would receive instruction while at home through a combination of synchronous and asynchronous digital delivery methods. This method may be more appropriate for students in higher grade levels who can be more self-directed.
