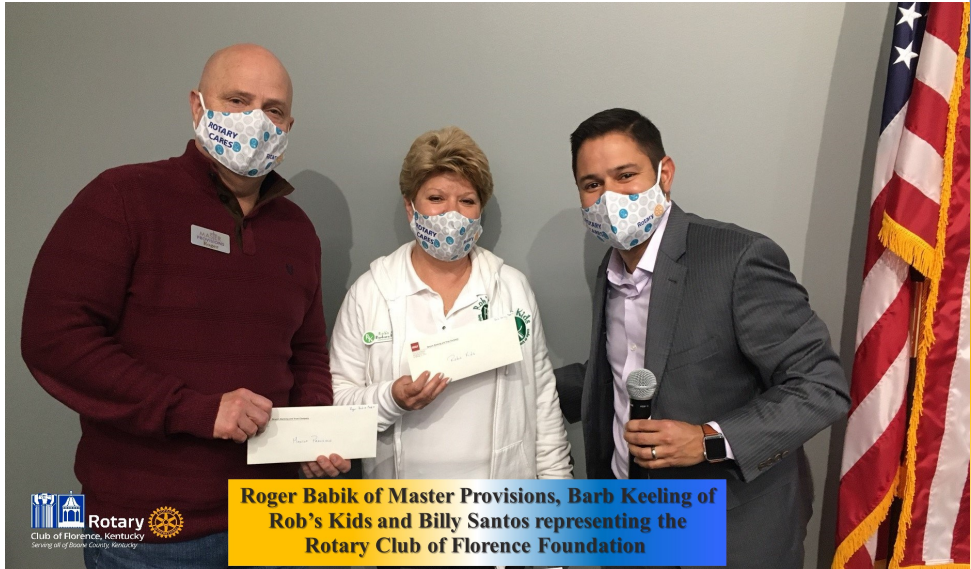

## Woman Promises Action In Announcing Candidacy

Mrs. Mary J. Middleton, 30 Ft. Mitchell Ave., Ft. Mitchell, yesterday formally announced her candidacy in the race for State Representative from the 58th District in Kenton County.

A Republican, Mrs. Middleton said that "as an average private citizen, I feel there is too much talk and too little action in the field of politics."

"Since many of our menfolk cannot make the necessary sacrifices to seek public office, unless they are professional politicians (and I believe it is these professionals who have given politics a bad name) it's up to the women."

Mrs. Middleton, who is the wife of Clyde W. Middleton, who is associated with the Procter and Gamble Co., is the mother of two children.

"Women in politics is nothing new," Mrs. Middleton said, "but it will be something new in Kenton County where the professionals have held court for too many long and lean years."

"Perhaps my entry will break the long-standing traditions and encourage other women to seek election in future races."
