Air Cargo is a Key Sector for our Region

As North America's 7th largest cargo airport, CVG keeps supply chains moving—especially during the pandemic.

More than **1.2 million tons** of cargo (largest in world only after Leipzig, Germany). More than **90% of DHL's Americas volume** passes through CVG every day. This activity provides an economic lifeline for the airport and bolsters regional employment.

- 50+ Non-Stop Destinations
- In otherwise normal times, about 12,000 passengers through TSA checkpoint/day (2019)
- 90%+ Local Origination
- 12 Passenger Carriers/Tour Operators

Air Cargo at CVG

"Epicenter of E-Commerce"

CVG is home to one of three DHL global super hubs (largest in world only after Leipzig, Germany). More than 90% of DHL's Americas volume passes through CVG every day.

Atlas Air Worldwide flies for many global companies, including DHL and Amazon. Atlas is building a new \$34 million operations center in Erlanger, located near CVG to support its sizable presence at the airport.

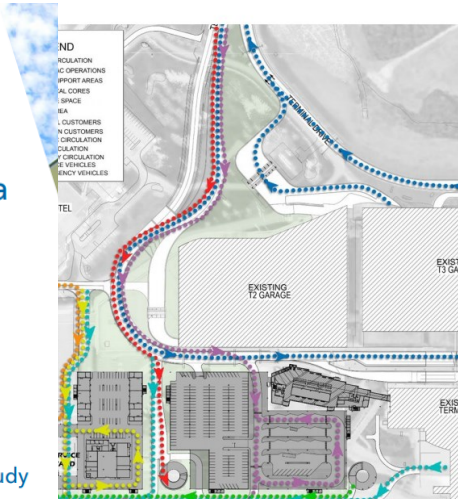

Construction on this project continues. Before the pandemic, CVG was serving more local passengers than ever, and that is anticipated to continue; entry roads and the front entrance of CVG require updating.

The ConRAC will be adjacent to the Terminal, provide space for more ticket counters (built when needed), and enable a streamlined rental car experience. It is slated for a fall 2021 completion.

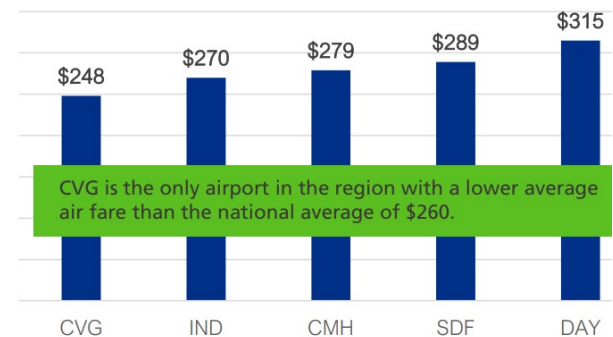
CVG 2021 Q1 DOT Top 100 Airfare Report
