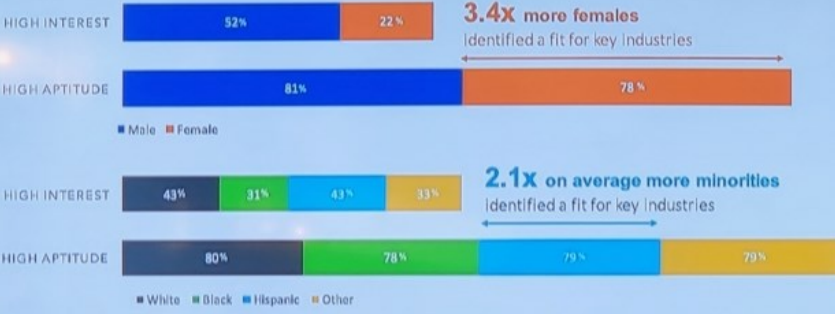

Demographics of Report



- There are roughly 2 available jobs per every job seeker in Northern Kentucky.
- There are approximately 14,000 job postings per month in the NKY 8-county area development district.
- Approximately 6,000 NKY Youth (ages 16-24) are not in school and not working.
- Jobs that pay a self-sufficient wage require training beyond high school.
- 75% of all jobs require some post-secondary training.
- Schools have been challenged to provide an adequate amount of career exploration activities for students.
