A candidate for Rotary Teacher of the Year should be an exceptionally dedicated, knowledgeable, and skilled teacher in any Boone County school (public or private), pre-kindergarten through grade twelve, who is planning to continue in an active teaching status. (Supervisory and administrative responsibilities should be of secondary consideration). It is the club's goal to honor local teachers deserving of recognition for their actions. "You do make a big difference in society," Rotary Club of Florence Sergeant at Arms and former Boone County Schools Board Member Shawn Carroll says. "You help folks get on the path to success."

To be eligible, your nominee must:

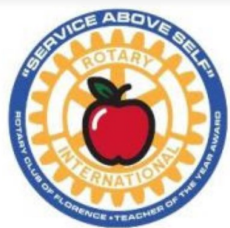
- Be currently employed as a teacher in a public or private school in Boone County
