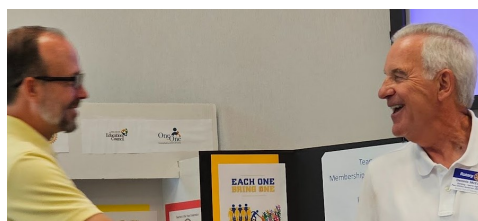
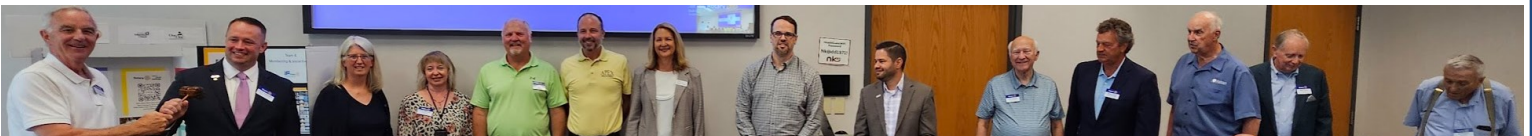

# CALL FOR CITIZEN OF THE YEAR NOMINATIONS

A candidate for Citizen of the Year should be a person or couple who has a heart to serve others. This typically is not someone who is constantly in the public eye but someone who “flies below the radar screen” and is not seeking public recognition.

## To be eligible, nominee must:

- Currently be a citizen of Northern Kentucky
- Have the respect and admiration of their friends, neighbors and peers
- Play an active and useful role in the community
- Exemplify the “Service above Self” standard in his or her professional and community involvement

The Citizen of the Year Award was created in 1995 and has honored over 35 inductees since its inception. Previous recipients have included teachers, pastors, doctors, coaches, neighbors, non-profit directors, postmasters, missionaries, administrators and many others.

Multiple letters of support are encouraged to demonstrate the nominee’s qualifications for the award.
