The Passing of the Gavel ceremony is a heartfelt ritual where each former president passes the gavel to their successor, signifying the continuity and unity of the club. It serves as a powerful reminder that the incoming president is not alone but rather supported by the collective strength and wisdom of the members.

Ian Addington was born and raised in Florence and has lived all but two years of his life here, growing up in the old Florence area on Belair Circle. To be eligible, nominee must:

- Currently be a citizen of Northern Kentucky
- Have the respect and admiration of their friends, neighbors and peers
- Play an active and useful role in the community
- Exemplify the "Service above Self" standard in his or her professional and community involvement

The Citizen of the Year Award was created in 1995 and has honored over 35 inductees since its inception. Previous recipients have included teachers, pastors, doctors, coaches, neighbors, non-profit directors, postmasters, missionaries, administrators and many others.
